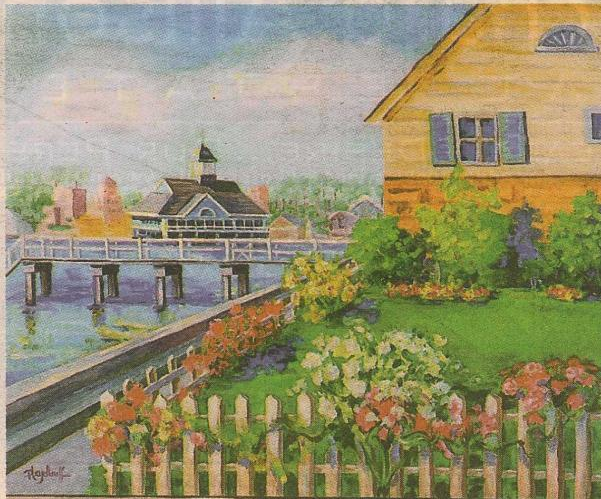


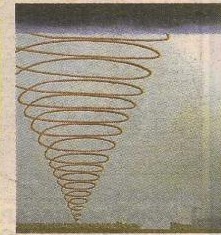

The Town of Jupiter Gallery of Art features the work of Pat Heydlauff and eight others in its show that opens Dec. 1.

Heydlauff's paints colorful landscapes, florals and still-lives and finds the process to be life enhancing.

"Through painting, I noticed that my life was becoming balanced, and filled with harmony instead of stress" she said of her first artistic endeavors.

For her, painting was a physical manifestation of her spiritual side, as she directed her energy through paint onto canvas. "I endeavor to convey a vital energy through sight, with color and design," she said, adding that work such
